



WILLIAM 'BILL' A BARTHLE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

The William "Bill" Albert Barthle Memorial Scholarship for college upperclassmen and graduate students studying agriculture has been established by the Barthle family, the Florida Cattlemen's Association (FCA) and the Florida Cattlemen's Foundation (FCF).

Bill was a past Pasco County Cattlemen's Association President, served numerous years as a FCA State Director, and was an involved member of the FCA Executive Committee for several years. He was the Chairman of the Pasco County Fair Association Beef Committee at the time of his passing in January of 2021.

PURPOSE:

Established in 2021, and initially awarded in 2022, to provide funds for educational assistance at the Junior/Senior or graduate, college level for qualified students to pursue an agricultural degree.

ADMINISTRATION:

The Florida Cattlemen's Foundation – Scholarship Committee

VALUE OF SCHOLARSHIP:

Two awards in the amount of \$1,000 will be awarded. This will be awarded at the annual FCA Annual Convention. The recipient (s) will be notified no later than May 15 of each year to allow for the opportunity to attend the awards ceremony at the convention, which is usually held during the month of June. Financial award maybe used for Tuition & Fees only. Award will be distributed in one single Semester and will be payable to the institution at which the student is enrolled in.

ELIGIBILITY:

- 1. The applicant must be a member of the FCA or have a family member of the Florida Cattlemen's Association in good standing at least six months prior to submitting application for scholarship (October 1 of year prior to applying in April).
- 2. Scholarship applicant must be enrolled as a full-time student in a Florida post-secondary state or private institution, and must have completed courses to satisfy at least the sophomore requirements, so that the student will be entering at least the junior year or post graduate courses during the year the scholarship is awarded.
- 3. Applicant must have an Agricultural related major of study
- 4. Applicant must show a minimum of a 2.0 GPA

APPLICATION:

- 1. Application Form
- 2. One (1) letter of recommendation.
- 3. Most up-to-date transcript available at time of submission.
- 4. Typed 300-600 word essay. Prompt:
 How has agriculture affected your life and what aspect will your college plans further your agricultural goals?
